Risk of contracting/spreading Corona Virus	Young people and adults	Chairs to be spread out as far as possible between young people in different family groups/bubbles  Hand sanitizer to be used on entry to the office and between touching/using different equipment  Windows and office door (if possible) to remain open to allow for good ventilation  Leaders can wear masks at their own discretion  Any leaders in vulnerable groups who haven't/can't be vaccinated should not attend	
Scolding by hot drinks	Young people and adults	All adults and young people should be sat down when handling hot drinks.	
Abuse of young people	Young people	All adults working in the Grid will undergo a full CRB enhanced disclosure, and will have filled in a Grid leader/helper role description, as well as reading the Copplestone Methodist Church	

Abuse towards adults	Adults	Safeguarding policy. There will always be at least two helpers in the room when young people are present. Ensure that there is always at least two Grid helpers/leaders present.	
Risky Activities (involving food/ equipment)	Young People and Adults	Ensure that all activities are risk assessed and that appropriate precautions are taken with food products and risky equipment.
